Best Practice I: Experiential Learning (EXL)

Experiential Learning (EXL) is a concept initially explored by John Dewey and Jean Piaget. It emphasizes learning through experience and is specifically defined as "learning through reflection on doing." EXL at the International Institute of Management Studies (IIMS) is designed to provide practical exposure to students, enabling them to apply theoretical knowledge in real-world scenarios. Key components of EXL include:

- Live projects from the Industry: Engaging students in hands-on projects to address industryspecific challenges.
- Internships (SIP + WIP): Offering Summer and Winter Internship Programs to provide workplace experience.
- Guided mentorship: Facilitating learning under the guidance of industry and academic experts.
- Simulation learning: Programs like Stock-Mock enhance practical understanding of market operations.
- International study tours: Exposing students to global business practices.
- Social projects: Encouraging community engagement and responsibility.
- Case writing and case-based teaching: Developing critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- Health and fitness initiatives for faculty and staff: Promoting overall well-being.
- Innovative syllabus design: Creating a dynamic and relevant curriculum.
